Our mission, since 2015, is to *inspire hope* with every pair of socks and flip-flops delivered to individuals and families whose lives have been changed from natural and man made disasters.

Sock'n It! was founded after Hurricane Katrina and after every hurricane, with the help of our supporters, we have been able to help protect the feet of others in need. In 2018, we included flip-flops for displaced, transient and unsheltered men, women and children in the Gulf Coast states from Florida to Texas - thousands of socks and flip-flops have been delivered.

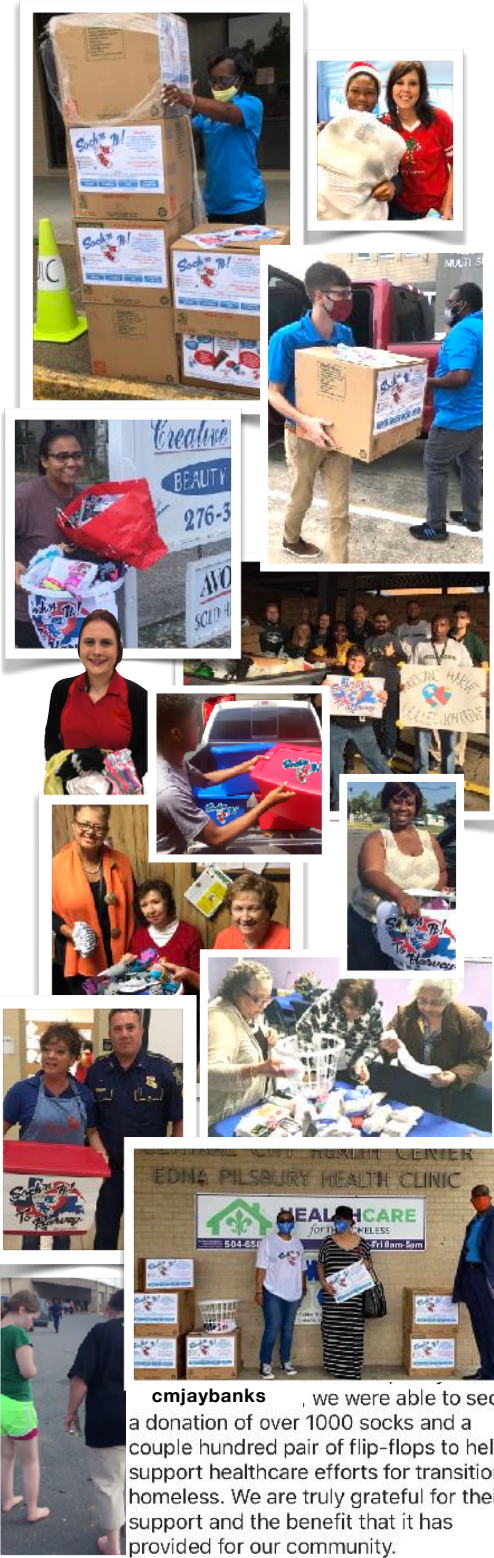
